Figuring out a course code:

OLC4O1

The first three letters identify the course.

6th character refers to the credit value of the course.
1 = 1 credit, 3= 1/2 credit, 6 = 1 credit Co-op, 8 = 2 credit Co-op

5th character (letter) identifies the course type/ destination:
E = Workplace C = College O = Open
U = University M = University/ College

4th character (number) identifies the grade:

3 = Grade 11

4 = Grade 12
